Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Loyabad, P.S. Case No. 07 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 127(2), 121(2), 109(1), 132, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S. 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that during the fight between two groups, the petitioner assaulted the informant, who being a member of patrolling party intervened to pacify the matter and other police personnel were also assaulted. It is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no intention to kill anybody and there is no allegation of use of any weapon against the injured. It is then submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 15 and he has been in custody since 06.03.2026 as mentioned in para-06 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-

(Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned JM, 1st Class at Dhanbad in connection with Loyabad, P.S. Case No. 07 of 2026 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
