This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is suffering from several ailments and he also has psychiatric problems for which reference has been made to various documents which have been brought on record.

It appears that the petitioner is suffering from some pains in the lower limbs and his sugar level is comparatively high. The ailments which are being suffered by the petitioner appears to be common in nature and there being no exceptional circumstance to grant exemption to surrender, this interlocutory application stands rejected.
