2. Looking to the averments made in this application, the same is allowed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to make necessary corrections in the cause-title in course of the day.

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4. With the consent of the parties, the matter is taken-up for hearing today itself.
5. The original petitioner had preferred this writ application for quashing the order dated 12.07.2011 issued by the 2nd respondent,

whereby a departmental proceeding under Rule-43(b) of the Jharkhand Pension Rules has been initiated against the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in paras-17 and 18 of the counter-affidavits, the respondents have specifically stated that the proceeding against the deceased employee has abated, therefore, they are not proceeding any further.

7. In view of fair submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ application stands dismissed as infructuous.

8. However, it is necessary to observe that any consequential benefits which will accrue to the legal heirs of the deceased employee shall be paid to the present petitioners as early as possible, preferably within a period of 16 weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order.
