I.A. No.4089 of 2025

I.A. No.4089 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 44 days.

2. Having heard learned counsel for petitioner and the learned APP and in view of the averments made in para 4 to 7 of the Interlocutory Application, the delay of 44 days in filing the instant Criminal Revision Application is condoned.

3. Thus, I.A. No.4089 of 2025 is allowed and stands disposed of.

I.A. No.12948 of 2024

4. I.A. No.12948 of 2024 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 438 and 442 of the BNSS, 2023 for staying the Distress Warrant issued against the petitioner for arrears of Rs.3,36,000/-.

5. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is ready to pay 50% of Rs.3,36,000/- (i.e. Rs.1,68,000/) to the O.P. No.2 within two weeks from today and hence Distress Warrant may be stayed.

6. Under the circumstances, put up this case on 17.04.2025 at 12.30 p.m and on or before that day, learned counsel for the petitioner may hand over the Demand Draft of Rs.1,68,000/- in the name of O.P. No.2 by filing supplementary affidavit to this effect.

7. However, no coercive step shall be taken against the petitioner till 17.04.2025.
