I.A No. 6836 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the appellant under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 95 days in filing this instant Criminal Appeal.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that due to financial crunch, the appellant could not file this Criminal Appeal within time. It is further submitted that the appellant is in custody since 30.11.2024 and hence, the delay of 95 days in filing this instant Criminal Appeal may be condoned.

3. Learned counsel for the Respondent No. 2 raised objection.

4. Having heard learned counsel for both the sides and in view of the averments made in Paragraph nos. 5 to 9 of the I.A No. 6836 of 2025, the delay of 95 days in filing this instant Criminal Appeal is, hereby, condoned.

5. Thus, I.A No. 6836 of 2025 is allowed and stands disposed of.

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6. It appears that pursuant to order dated 18.08.2025 notice was issued upon the informant through Superintendent of Police, Chaibasa.

7. However, when the case is called out, none appears on behalf of the informant though, notice was served upon the informant.

8. Put up this case on 6th November 2025 awaiting appearance of the informant, by way of last chance.
