2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dhanwar PS Case No.218 of 2025, for offence registered under section 191(2), 352, 118(1), 115(2), 127(1), 109, 74, 117(2), 303(2), 351(2), 324(4) of BNS, 2023, pending in court of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Giridih.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that altercation took place due to land dispute and there are case and counter case between the parties. He next submits that six co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the learned Sessions Judge vide impugned order itself.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that allegation of altercation is there.

5. Considering that there are case and counter case

between the parties and the altercation took place due to land dispute and it has been pointed out that both the sides have received injury and some of the accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the learned Sessions Judge, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to both the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, both the petitioners, above named, are hereby directed to surrender before learned court within three weeks from today, and in event of their surrender/arrest, petitioners, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of like amount each, to satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Giridih, in connection with Dhanwar PS Case No.218 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
