Heard the learned counsel for the respective sides.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for condoning the delay of 1165 days in filing the revision application.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was not aware that there was a statutory period for filing the revision application, which led to the delay in filing the same. Learned counsel submits that in fact the petitioner has compromised the matter with the opposite party no.2 and an amount of Rs.6,00,000/- has already been extended to the opposite party no.2.

Learned counsel appearing for the opposite party no.2 has accepted the factum of compromise and the receipt of Rs.6,00,000/- towards the terms and conditions of the compromise.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the entire amount has been extended to the opposite party no.2, I am inclined to condone the delay of 1165 days in filing the revision application. Accordingly, the instant application is allowed and the delay of 1165 days in filing the revision application is condoned.

I.A. stands disposed of.

I.A. No. 11045 of 2025

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The reason which has been assigned in the instant application is

of a compromise which has been effected between both the parties and the terms and conditions have been fulfilled by the petitioner leading to extension of an amount of Rs.6,00,000/-in favour of the opposite party no.2. The said fact has been reiterated by the opposite party no.2.

Regard being had to the compromise which has been effected and the same being an exceptional circumstance, the petitioner is exempted to surrender before the learned trial Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 2925/2013.

I.A. stands disposed of.
