From the show cause, it appears that the O.P. No.2 is trying to shift its responsibility for compliance with the order by submitting that it is only the Deputy Commissioner who will enquire into the matter. After perusing the writ court's order, it is evident that there is no scope for any enquiry and the post held by the opposite party no.2 is much and much higher than that of the Deputy Commissioner; as such, it is expected that O.P. No.2 shall ensure that the order is complied with before the next date of hearing. In any case, when the State of Jharkhand is a party, this Court is not concerned with which officer or authority is the opposite party; the concern of this Court is only to see whether the order has been complied with or not.

From the entire show cause, it appears that on the one hand, they are accepting the order, but on the other hand, in effect, they are not complying with the order.

Be that as it may, with a view to give one more opportunity for proper compliance and filing compliance report by O.P. No.2.
