1. None appears on behalf of the petitioner.
2. It appears that in the present criminal revision, vide order dated 26.07.2023, with the consent of both the parties, the matter was referred to mediation before the JHALSA and in that view of the matter, the further proceeding in connection with Protest-cum-Complaint Case No. 1011 of 2011, arising out of Bariatu P.S. Case No. 391 of 2010 was stayed. Accordingly, the mediation proceeded and the report, at Flag-‘J’, was submitted by the JHALSA that the mediation was not taken-off and remains a non-starter.
3. Thereafter, again vide order dated 27.09.2023, with the consent of the parties, the matter was referred to mediation before the JHALSA and the interim order was made effective for the next date. The mediation report, at Flag-‘H’, was submitted by the JHALSA that there is no possibility of any conciliation between the parties and it was failed.
4. It further appears that till then the stay order was continuing without any valid reason and the petitioner is also not taking any interest in this criminal revision.

5. Therefore, earlier stay order dated 26.07.2023 passed in this case and further stay order continuing dated 27.09.2023, 20.12.2023, 30.04.2024, 19.06.2024, 01.07.2024, 01.08.2025, does not appear to be justifiable.
6. Accordingly, the stay order dated 26.07.2023 is hereby vacated.
7. List this case after two weeks for hearing on merits.
