2. Learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 has submitted that the matter may be again referred for mediation before the JHALSA, so that the parties may be able to settle their dispute.
3. Under the circumstances, with the consent of learned counsel for both the sides, the matter is referred to mediation before the JHALSA and it will be desirable that both the parties i.e. the petitioner and opposite party no. 2 shall remain present before the learned Member Secretary, JHALSA on 10.10.2023. Thereafter, the Member Secretary, JHALSA will appoint a Trained and Experienced Mediator instantly to amicably settle the dispute between both the sides and make an effort for reconciliation between both the sides also and the Member Secretary, JHALSA shall submit a report to this Court on or before 22.11.2023.
4. Put up this case on 28.11.2023.
5. Till then, interim order dated 26.07.2023 passed by this Court shall continue.

6. Let a copy of this order be handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 and be also sent to learned Member Secretary, JHALSA for the needful.
