It has been submitted by learned senior counsel for the appellant that appellant, Amjad Gaddi has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 302 of I.P.C. No charge for the offence punishable under Section 27 of the Arms Act has been framed against the appellant and as such he has renewed his prayer for bail by filing I.A. No. 4058 of 2021 along with supplementary affidavit stating therein that no charge for the offence punishable under Section 27 of the Arms Act has been framed against the appellant as such the conviction of the appellant under Section 302/34 in absence of conviction of co- accused, namely, Afroj @ Chima, Mobin, Wasim @ Tamin, who have been acquitted, is not sustainable in the eye of law.

Let the State file counter affidavit through Directorate of the prosecution on this issue.
