Heard Mr.Mukesh Bihari Lal, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and none appears on behalf of the State.

This is the fourth attempt made by the appellant for grant of bail.

Submission has been advanced by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant is in custody since 04.10.2016. It has further been submitted that there are contradictions in the evidence of the eye witnesses and in fact such evidence does not corroborate the findings made in the postmortem report. It appears that one Anjan Vishwakarma was shot dead and the witnesses have stated about the present appellant being instrumental in committing the murder of Anjan Vishwakarma.

Regard being had to the evidence of the witnesses including the postmortem report, we are not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the appellant, which stands rejected once again.

The I.A stands disposed of.
