 This application has been preferred by the appellant for grant of provisional bail to him for a period of one month on account of the marriage ceremony of his sister-in-law.

 It has been submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that the parents of his sister-in-law are no more and the appellant is the only male member in the family and therefore his presence is required in the marriage ceremony of his sister-in-law.

 Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the appellant.

 It seems from the marriage card which has been brought on record that there is mention of some other persons also in the family members of the sister-in-law of the appellant. In such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant provisional bail to the appellant and the same is hereby rejected.

 I.A. No. 3654 of 2026 stands rejected.
