02/31.07.2023 It has been submitted by Mr. Lukesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is claiming compassionate appointment on account of the death of her mother-in-law who had died in harness while working as Aaganwari Seviaka. It has further been submitted that as per the Resolution dated 30.09.2022, the petitioner is entitled to be appointed as a Sahaika in the same Aaganwari Kendra. Learned counsel submits that though the respondent no. 7 has been appointed as an Aaganwari Seviaka in Nichitpur-2 the petitioner does not have any grievance against the respondent no. 7 as the petitioner is claiming compassionate appointment on the post of Sahaika in Nichitpur-2 which is still vacant.

Mr. Shivam Pathak, learned A.C. to S.C.-III for the respondent-State prays for and is allowed four weeks' time to file a counter affidavit.
