1. Heard Mr. Mayank Mohit Sinha, learned counsel for the appellant and learned Spl. P.P.
2. This application has been preferred by the appellant for grant of bail to him during the pendency of this appeal.
3. The appellant has been convicted for the offence under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and has been sentenced to undergo R.I. for life along with fine of Rs.10,000/-.
4. It has been alleged that on account of an altercation between the appellant and his son, the son of the appellant was assaulted by him with a tangi which resulted in his death. The informant is the wife of the deceased as well as the daughter-in-law of the appellant, who is an eye witness and she has stated about the manner in which the assault was committed by the appellant upon his son which is corroborated by the Post-mortem Report.
5. Though it has been submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant is in custody since 18.12.2019 but regarding being had to the act of assault attributed to the

appellant, we are not inclined to admit the appellant on bail. His prayer for bail is hereby rejected at this stage.

6. Accordingly, I.A. No.5330 of 2024 stands rejected.
