Consequently, I.A. No. 7235 of 2026 stand disposed of.
Heard Mr. Ritesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with
Jaldega P.S. Case No. 67 of 2025.

It has been alleged that a Mob had committed assault upon the
owner of the Dhaba and also vandalized the Dhaba and when the police
party had arrived, they were also abused and assaulted.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the
petitioners that the main allegation of instigating the mob and taking an
active part in committing the assault is attributed to Vishal Nayak and
Nisha Baraik.

Learned counsel submits that so far as the present petitioners are
concerned, the allegations against the petitioners, are general and
ominous in nature.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory
bail of the petitioners.

Regard being had to the allegations levelled against the petitioners
and the fact is that the main allegation seems to be levelled against Vishal
Nayak and Nisha Baraik, I am inclined to extend the privilege of
anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the petitioners above named are directed to
surrender in the court below within four weeks and pray for bail, and in

that event, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Simdega in connection with Jaldega P.S. Case No. 67 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

This application stands allowed.
