1. Heard Mr. Choudhary, learned counsel for the applicant and Mr. Ankit Kumar, A.C to G.P.-VI, for the State.
2. Mr. Choudhary states that the private respondent has been duly served in this matter. This I.A seeks condonation of delay of 155 days in filing the review petition.
3. The main reason is that the applicant had challenged this Court's order before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. However, the Special Leave Petition was withdrawn with liberty to file a review before the High Court. This withdrawal with liberty was allowed on 21.04.2025. Soon thereafter, this review petition was filed.
