The petitioner is an accused in S.T. Case No. 461/2025, arising out of Bodam P.S. Case No. 32 of 2025, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1265 of 2025.

The mother of the informant was murdered and suspicion was cast upon the petitioner and others who had earlier threatened her for practicing witchcraft.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the only incriminating material against the petitioner is the fact that the *Dauli* was recovered from the house of the petitioner which however has not been ascertained to be the murder weapon. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 07.01.2026.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-V, Jamshedpur in connection with in S.T. Case No. 461/2025, arising out of Bodam P.S. Case No. 32 of 2025, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1265 of 2025.
