1. Heard Mr. Subodh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl. PP.
2. The petitioner is an accused in connection with Marafari P.S Case No. 54 of 2025, G.R. No. 1132 of 2025.
3. The prayer for bail of the petitioner was earlier rejected in B.A No. 11234 of 2025.
4. It has been alleged that the cyber criminals had hacked the ATM machine and withdrawn the amount of Rs. 3, 87, 999.99/- from the account of the husband of the informant.
5. Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the husband of the informant has not lost any money. He further submits that the petitioner has two criminal antecedents but none are related to cyber crime and so far, only 3 prosecution witnesses have been examined. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 20.09.2025.
6. Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.
7. Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Session Judge-II-Cum-Special Judge, Cyber Crime Cases, Deoghar, in connection with Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No. 40 of 2026, subject to the condition that one of the bailers should be a close relative of the petitioner and the petitioner shall physically appear before the learned Trial Court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial, unless prevented by sufficient cause.
8. This application stands **allowed**.
