03/19.10.2020: The office has pointed out the defect in respect of shortage of court fees.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes that he will deposit the court fees within three weeks from today.

Undertaking, given by the counsel for the petitioners, is accepted. The deficit court fees should be deposited within three weeks. Other defects, as pointed out by the office, stand ignored for the present.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute is between the neighbours on trivial issue and there is chance for compromise from the side of his clients.

In that view, issue notice to opposite party No. 2, for which, requisites etc. under registered cover with A/D as well as ordinary process must be filed within three weeks.

List this case after service of notice or appearance of opposite party No. 2, whichever is earlier.

In the meantime, considering the nature of dispute and the submission made by the counsel for the petitioners, further proceeding in connection with Complaint Case No. 2247 of 2018, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ranchi, so far as it relates to the petitioners, shall remain stayed.
