2/04.06.2026 Heard Mr. A.K. Rashidi, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP assisted by Ms. Pinky Kumari, learned counsel appearing for the informant.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Harla P.S. Case No.181 of 2025.

The parents of the informant were murdered by unknown persons.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he has been implicated on the confession of co-accused-Om Prakash @ Lalua, consequent to which the petitioner had also confessed.

Learned counsel adds that the petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2025.

Learned A.P.P. for the State as well as the learned counsel for the informant have opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the informant has submitted that on the confession of the petitioner, the mobile of the deceased, the brick which was used in the murder and the blood-stained cloths kept in the house of the petitioner were recovered.

It has been submitted that the blood found on the brick has matched with the blood of the deceased which furthermore strengthens the case of the prosecution about the petitioner being directly involved in committing the murder of the parents of the informant.

Regard being had to the strong circumstantial evidence emanating from the above, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is hereby rejected.

This bail application is **rejected**.
