2/04.06.2026 Heard Mr. J.N. Upadhyay, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl. PP for the State assisted by Mr. Ritesh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the informant.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with S.T. Case No.69 of 2026 arising out of Birsanagar P.S. Case No. 93 of 2025.

It has been alleged that the accused persons had committed robbery in the office of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been implicated on the confession of Malik Mudliyar.

Learned counsel submits that on the confession of the petitioner, Rs.45,000/-, a mobile, a scooty, a country made pistol and two live cartridges were recovered.

It has been submitted that no looted article was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and he is in custody since 18.11.2025.

Learned Spl. PP for the State as well as the learned counsel for the informant have opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VI, East Singhbhum at Jamshedpur in connection with S.T. Case No.69 of 2026 arising out of Birsanagar P.S. Case No. 93 of 2025.

This bail application stands **allowed**.
