Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this interlocutory application has been filed with the prayer to ignore the defects pointed out by the stamp reporter at Serial No.53 which is to the effect that the documents of the Annexure-1 is not complete and enclosure-6 at page no.24 seems to be missing.

It is next submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the absence of the enclosures will not prejudice the hearing, hence, the same be ignored.

Considering the facts of this case, this Court do not find any justifiable reason to allow the petitioner to suppress part of the Annexure-1 which is the application filed by the Narcotic Control Bureau before the Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi, hence the prayer to ignore the defect pointed out by the stamp reporter is rejected.

Accordingly, this interlocutory application is rejected.
