Heard the parties.

The petitioners have moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with S.T. No. 181 of 2025 arising out of Kandra P.S. Case No.22 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 103(2)/238(a)/61(2) (a)/3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that the petitioners in criminal conspiracy with the co-accused persons have committed murder of the wife of the informant Mainu Manjhian. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioners are all false and the petitioners are not named in the FIR. It is also submitted that charge sheet has been submitted and charge has been framed but no witness has been examined as yet. It is then submitted that the petitioners have been implicated in this case only on the basis of the confessional statement of the co-accused persons. It is next submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent as has been mentioned in paragraph no.17 of the bail application. It is then submitted that the petitioners have been in custody since 10.06.2025, as submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners. It is next submitted that the petitioners undertake to cooperate

with the trial of the case and further undertake that they will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. It is lastly submitted that the co-accused person with similar allegation has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 14.05.2026 in B.A. No.4080 of 2026. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioners be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the abovenamed petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.S.J.-I, Seraikella, in connection with S.T. No. 181 of 2025 arising out of Kandra P.S. Case No.22 of 2025 with the condition that the petitioners will cooperate with the trial of the case and will furnish their mobile numbers and a copy of their Aadhar Cards in the court below with the undertaking that they will not change their mobile numbers during the trial of the case, with further condition that they will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
