The petitioner is an accused in S.T. No. 10/2026, arising out of Bariyatu P.S. Case No. 47/2025.

The petitioner and other accused persons were apprehended by the Police as they were planning to commit an offence. Several incriminating articles were recovered from their possession.

It appears that so far as the petitioner is concerned, one pistol with five cartridges was recovered. One of the co-accused has been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No. 3978 of 2026. The petitioner is in custody since 27.09.2025.

Regard being had to the period of custody, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Latehar in S.T. No. 10/2026, arising out of Bariyatu P.S. Case No. 47/2025.
