2/04.06.2026 Heard Mr. J.N. Upadhyay, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Burmamines P.S. Case No. 16 of 2026.

The petitioner is alleged to have enticed away the daughter of the informant for the purposes of marriage.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the victim was recovered from the custody of the petitioner.

It has been submitted that in her statement recorded under Section 180 of BNSS, she has categorically stated that there was a love affair between her and the petitioner and that no physical relationship was established by the petitioner.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in custody since 22.03.2026.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the statement of the victim, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Jamshedpur in connection with Burmamines P.S. Case No. 16 of 2026.

This bail application stands **allowed**.
