2/04.06.2026 Heard Mr. R.S. Mazumdar, learned senior counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl. PP for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Bankmore P.S. Case No. 219 of 2022.

It has been alleged that the Officer-in-Charge of Bankmore P.S. had received information that some miscreants have entered Muthoot Fin Corp. The miscreants tried to flee away by firing at the police which was retaliated and one of the miscreants had died. Two of the miscreants were apprehended by the police.

It appears that the petitioner was one of the persons who was apprehended at the spot.

Though it has been submitted by learned senior counsel for the petitioner that he is in custody since 08.09.2022 and that out of 19 witnesses only 10 witnesses have been examined so far, but regard being had to the fact that the petitioner was apprehended at the spot by the police, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is hereby rejected.

This bail application is **rejected**.
