Heard Mr. Rajesh Kr Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.

2. The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in connection with Chatra Sadar P.S. Case No. 187 of 2023.
3. The informant had come to know that Sugiya Devi and her paramour have been assaulted by the accused persons on account of which Sugiya Devi had died. The dead body was also burnt.
4. So far as the allegations are concerned, it seems to be general and omnibus in nature against the petitioner, who is a female.
5. Regard being had to the above, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks and pray for bail, and in that event, she shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra in connection with Chatra Sadar P.S. Case No. 187 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
7. This application stands *allowed*.
