The petitioner is an accused in connection with Chandil P.S. Case No. 10 of 2026.

It has been alleged that the sister of the informant had died in her matrimonial house in unnatural circumstances.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the brother-in-law of the deceased who is in custody since 14.01.2026 and the post-mortem report reveals that cause of death is asphyxia due to hanging. It is further submitted that the allegation levelled against the petitioner is general and omnibus in nature.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., at Chandil in connection with Chandil P.S. Case No. 10 of 2026.

This application stands **allowed**.
