Heard Mr. Rahul Dev, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl.P.P.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Rail (Hatia) P.S. Case No. 04 of 2026.

3. One Mohan Prasad was apprehended and 7.5kg of *Ganja* was recovered from his possession.

4. Submission has been advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been implicated on the confession of Mohan Prasad, who has subsequently expired during the pendency of the case.

5. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent.

6. Learned Spl.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Regard being had to the manner of implication of the petitioner, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

8. Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks and pray for bail, and in that event, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi in connection with Rail (Hatia) P.S. Case No. 04 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the *Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita*, 2023.

9. This application stands *allowed*.
