This application has been preferred by the appellant no. 1 for grant of bail to him during the pendency of this appeal.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the appellant no. 1 that the appellant no. 1 is mother-in-law of the deceased. It has further been submitted that the appellant no. 1 is in custody since 26.03.2021 and the evidence of the independent witnesses suggests that there was cordial relationship between the deceased and the appellant no. 1.

Regard being had to the period of custody undergone by the appellant no. 1 and the other circumstances as submitted by learned counsel for the appellant no. 1, we are inclined to admit the appellant no. 1 on bail. Accordingly, during the pendency of this appeal, appellant no. 1, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like

amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Distt. & Addl. Sessions Judge-II, Fast Track Court (Crime Against Woman), Bermo at Tenughat in Sessions Trial No. 172 of 2021.

The aforesaid I.A. stands allowed and disposed of.
