Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks amendment in the prayer portion as well as relevant paras of main writ petition, by incorporating the prayer as made in paragraph no. 5 of the interlocutory application, which has been necessitated due to subsequent development of facts. He further submits that if the proposed amendment is not allowed, the petitioner shall suffer irreparable loss and injury and by allowing the proposed amendment, the nature of the writ petition shall not be changed.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has no objection to the same.
