1. Heard Mr. Abhay Kr. Chaturvedy, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.
2. The prayer for bail of the petitioner was earlier rejected in B.A. No. 10605 of 2024 and B.A. No. 7736 of 2025.
3. Though it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner while referring to the evidence of the victim who has been examined as P.W.-1 that it was at the instance of her husband, the case has been instituted and the fact that petitioner is in custody since 18.12.2023 and there is no progress in the trial but regard being had to the nature of allegations leveled against the petitioner which suggests that he had committed rape upon the informant, I am not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the petitioner, which stands rejected, once again, at this stage.
