2/04.06.2026 Heard Mr. Ankit Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No. 54 of 2026.

The petitioner was apprehended by the police and from his possession, one mobile with SIM was recovered. He was suspected to be involved in cyber crime.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no victim has come forward to lodge a complaint. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has one criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 12.04.2026.

Learned Spl.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-cyber-crime-Special Court, Deoghar in connection with 54 of 2026, subject to the condition that one of the bailor should be a close relative of the petitioner and he shall remain physically present before the trial court on each and every date till the conclusion of trial, unless prevented by sufficient cause.
