The petitioner is an accused in connection with Bhandariya P.S. Case No. 18 of 2026.

It has been alleged that the brother of the informant was fired upon by the petitioner and another.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner of firing at the deceased. Learned counsel submits that in course of investigation, it was detected that the firing was made by Vijay Singh and Jethu Singh. Learned counsel further submits that there has been a land dispute between the parties and a civil suit is also pending which was the reason for the false implication of the petitioner. Learned counsel adds that the petitioner is in custody since 28.02.2026.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Garhwa in connection with Bhandariya P.S. Case No. 18 of 2026.

This application stands **allowed**.
