Regard being had to the above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned JMFC, Palamu at Daltonganj in connection with Manatu P.S. Case No. 07 of 2026.
