The petitioner is an accused in connection with NDPS Case No.06 of 2025 corresponding to Petarwar P.S. Case No. 127 of 2025.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was earlier dismissed as withdrawn in B.A. No.438 of 2026.

The petitioner and another accused were apprehended by the police and 1 kg of Ganja was recovered. On their confession, a raid was conducted in the house of Chintu Saw and 76 kg of Ganja was recovered. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in similar circumstances one of the co-accused has been granted bail in B.A. No.2577 of 2026. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in custody since 15.10.2025.

Learned Spl. P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the fact that in similar circumstances one of the co-accused has been granted bail, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Bokaro in connection with NDPS Case No.06 of 2025 corresponding to Petarwar P.S. Case No. 127 of 2025.
