**02/04.06.2026** Heard Mr. Rahul Ranjan, learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Deoghar Cyber P.S. Case No. 56 of 2026.

The petitioner and another accused were apprehended by the police and from their possession mobile phones along with SIMs were recovered and they were suspected to be involved in cybercrime.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no victim has come forward to lodge any complaint. Learned counsel adds that the petitioner is in custody since 14.04.2026 and petitioner has one criminal antecedent with respect to similar nature of offence.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Cyber Crime, Special Court, Deoghar in connection with Deoghar Cyber P.S. Case No. 56 of 2026 subject to the condition that one of the bailors should be a close relative of the petitioner and he shall physically remain present before the learned trial Court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial.

This application stands **allowed**.
