1. Heard Mr. K.S. Nanda, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP.
2. The petitioner is an accused in connection with Bano P.S. Case No.15 of 2026.
3. The petitioner and others were suspected to be involved in illegal sale and purchase of bovine animals for the purposes of slaughtering. The petitioner is alleged to have been implicated in this case on the confession of the co-accused.
4. Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.
5. Although the petitioner has got two criminal antecedents but regard being had to the manner of implication and the fact that he is in custody since 02.05.2026, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Simdega, in connection with Bano P.S. Case No.15 of 2026.
