1. Heard Mr. Prathik, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP.
2. The petitioner is an accused in connection with Cyber Crime Case No.03 of 2026 arising out of Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No.130 of 2025.
3. The petitioner and some other accused persons were apprehended by the police and from their possession mobile phones with SIM Cards were recovered. They were suspected to be involved in cyber-crime.
4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no victim has come forward to lodge any complaint. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2025 and he has one criminal antecedent of similar nature of offence.
5. Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.
6. Regard being had to the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Deoghar in connection with Cyber Crime Case No.03 of 2026 arising out of Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No.130 of 2025 subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner and the petitioner shall physically appear before the learned trial court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial.
