The petitioner is an accused in connection with Kuru P.S. Case No. 34 of 2026.

It has been alleged that 19 grams of brown sugar were recovered from the joint possession of the petitioner and co-accused.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that 10 grams of brown was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and recovered quantity of brown sugar from the joint possession of the petitioner and co-accused is intermediate quantity. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in custody since 02.04.2026 and he does not have any criminal antecedent.

Learned Spl.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Principal District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Lohardaga in connection with Kuru P.S. Case No. 34 of 2026.

This application stands **allowed**.
