This interlocutory application has been filed praying therein to allow the petitioners to take substituted service of notice upon respondent Nos. 7 and 17 by publishing the same in newspaper in terms of Order V Rule 20(1) of the Code of Civil Procedure.

After going through the petition, I find that there is nothing on record to suggest that the defendant is keeping himself out of the way for the purpose of avoiding service nor there is anything to suggest that there exists reasons so that the summons cannot be served in ordinary way.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays to withdraw this interlocutory application with liberty to allow them to serve notice personally upon respondent Nos. 7 and 17.

Considering the aforesaid submission, the prayer is allowed.

Let personal service be effected by the petitioners upon respondent Nos. 7 and 17 for which, requisites etc. must be filed within two weeks.

After serving the notice personally, the petitioners will file appropriate affidavit in support of service of notice.

Accordingly, this application stands **disposed of**.
