**02/10.06.2026** Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the learned counsel appearing for the State.

**2.** The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Parsudih P.S. Case No.68 of 2023, for the alleged offences registered under Sections 498A and 304B of Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, pending in the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur.

**3.** Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioners happened to be elder brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the informant. He further submits that the alleged occurrence is

said to be dated 29.11.2021 whereas the complaint case has been filed on 23.05.2023 which was subsequently converted into FIR. He then submits that father-in-law and mother-in-law have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in ABA No.1783 of 2026. He next submits that the petitioners are residing in another house. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted.

**4.** Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that allegations are there against the petitioners and the case is registered under Sections 498A and 304B of Indian Penal Code as well as Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

**5.** In the order of learned Sessions Judge, it has come that the petitioners are not residing at the place of occurrence and they are residing in another house and the alleged occurrence is said to be dated 29.11.2021 whereas the complaint case has been lodged on 23.05.2023 which has been converted into FIR and father-in-law and mother-in-law have already been granted anticipatory bail in the aforesaid ABA, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

**6.** Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of their surrender/arrest, the petitioners, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with

two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur in connection with Parsudih P.S. Case No.68 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
