Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Mandar P.S. Case No.43 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 406/420/34/467/468 of the Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner duped the teachers and staffs of St. Anne Convent School to the tune of Rs.14,27,969.50. It is next submitted that the petitioner has already supplied goods worth Rs.22,62,061/- that consist of 57 Tablets and 50 Laptops to St. Anne Intermediate College. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the dispute between the parties is basically a civil dispute. It is then submitted that though charge sheet has been submitted in this case but no witness has been examined as yet. It is then submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.01.2026, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 01 of the bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the abovenamed petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., Ranchi, in connection with Mandar P.S. Case No.43 of 2025 with the condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and a copy of his Aadhar Card in the court below with the undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
