(i), (ii) and (iii) are concerned, the petitioner has prayed to stop construction of Transmission Line and erection of Tower, but, in view of section-10(d) of the Indian Telegraph Act, the petitioner can only get adequate compensation which has already been prayed for by the petitioner at prayer no. (iv).

2. So far as payment of compensation and acquisition of the land is concerned, the respondents are directed to file counter affidavit within six weeks.

3. Pendency of this writ petition will not come in the way of the respondents to pay compensation to the petitioner and to initiate the process for acquisition of the land.
