2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Tetulmari P.S. Case No.05 of 2026, for the alleged offences
registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 62, 109(1), 132
and 329(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the Court
of learned J.M., Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner happened to be a villager and the allegations are
made of taking the coal. He further submits that however CISF
personnels have reached to the spot and the allegations are made
of pelting stones. He then submits that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.13 of the petition.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that allegation of pelting stones is there.

5. Considering that the petitioner was collecting coal for preparing food and the petitioner is said to be poor villager and there are general and omnibus allegation of pelting stones upon 9 named accused persons and 15 unknown persons and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.13 of the petition, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of J.M., Dhanbad in connection with Tetulmari P.S. Case No.05 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
