04/18.06.2026 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that for ignoring defect no.89(a), I.A. No.7847 of 2026 has been filed. He further submits that all these petitioners have approached for anticipatory bail before the learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi and in the cause-title of the A.B.P. No.1260 of 2026, the names of the petitioners are disclosed as Tanesh Kachhap and others. He next submits that in the said A.B.P., all these petitioners were parties and to buttress this submission, he refers to the case status annexed at Annexure-1 of the said I.A.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the State also accepts the said submission.

3. In view of the case status annexed at Annexure-1 of the said I.A., it transpires that these petitioners were also parties as petitioners in A.B.P. No.1260 of 2026. In the cause-title of the order passed by the learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi, the petitioners are shown as Tanesh Kachhap and others, meaning thereby all these petitioners were parties in the said A.B.P.

4. In view of the above, defect no.89(a) is ignored.

5. Accordingly, I.A. No.7847 of 2026 is allowed and disposed of.
