02/12.06.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with B.S. City P.S. Case No.72 of 2026, registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 109 read with Section 3(5) of the BNS, 2023, pending in the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bokaro.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioner no.1 is the father of Hare Ram Sah and petitioner nos. 2 and 3 are brothers of Hare Ram Sah and Karan Sah respectively. He next submits that the allegations of assault by knife are there against Hare Ram Sah and Karan Sah and they are already in judicial custody. He further submits that so far as these petitioners are concerned, there are general and omnibus allegations against them. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted to the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the petitioners were also involved in scuffle.

5. Looking into the contents of the FIR, it transpires that there is only allegation against these petitioners of throwing the informant. So far as the allegation of assault by knife is concerned, that allegation is there against Hare Ram Sah and Karan Sah. The petitioners are said to be relatives of Hare Ram Sah and Karan Sah. Further, it has been pointed out that these petitioners are having no criminal antecedents, as disclosed in paragraph 9 of this application. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender, they shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bokaro in connection with B.S. City P.S. Case No.72 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
