2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Peterwar PS Case No.169 of 2023, corresponding to G.R. No.1239 of 2023, for offence registered under section 379, 411, 34 of Indian Penal Code, pending in court of learned S.D.J.M., Bermo at Tenughat.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that false allegations are made of storing coal in a particular land and loading the same on the tractor. He next submits that the names of the petitioners have come on secret information. He further submits that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.14 of the petition. He next submits that in identical situation, the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail in ABA Nos.3043 of 2024 and 5268 of 2025. On these grounds,

he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted to the petitioners.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that allegations are there of storing coal on a particular land.

5. Considering that the name of the petitioners have been taken by some unknown persons and the name of the person who has taken the name of the petitioners has not been disclosed in in the FIR and in identical situation, the other accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail as aforesaid, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners.

6. Accordingly, petitioners, above named, are hereby directed to surrender before learned court within three weeks from today, and in event of their surrender/arrest, petitioners, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of like amount each, to satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Bermo at Tenughat, in connection with Peterwar PS Case No.169 of 2023, corresponding to G.R. No.1239 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
