- 1.** The instant application has been filed for restoration of Contempt Case (Civil) No. 653 of 2023 to its original file, which stood dismissed for default on 26.07.2024 for non-compliance of order dated 12.07.2024.
- 2.** It has been stated that this Court vide order dated 12.07.2024 directed to remove the defect within a period of two weeks, as pointed out by the office failing which the contempt petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.
- 3.** It has been submitted that the petitioner is an old-ailing person and as such he could not come to court to file supplementary affidavit due to his illness.

4. Submission has been made that as soon as the restoration shall stand restored, the petitioner would remove the defect at an earliest.
